Dear School Administrator,

I'd like to invite you to participate in a fun and exciting initiative called Sun Day-Fun Day, administered by The National Children's Cancer Society (NCCS)! The purpose of the program is twofold: to promote sun safety at your school and to give students the opportunity to work together to raise money for kids their own age who have cancer. Research shows that sunburns in childhood can cause skin cancer in adulthood. We want to promote sun safety in your school to help minimize that risk! This letter gives you an overview of the program and all of the information you need to get started at your school.

Your school can commit to Sun Day-Fun Day by promoting sun safety and encouraging fundraising on behalf of the NCCS at the same time. You can decide the time frame for your event, but we recommend a minimum of one week. The NCCS has created Sun Day-Fun Day posters, grade-appropriate sun safety activities, fundraising materials, and many other great resources to make the program easy to coordinate and fun for everyone! In addition to learning about sun safety, students have an opportunity to help raise money to support children with cancer. The NCCS will award \$50 for a party to the classroom at your school that raises the most money for children with cancer. (The minimum amount that must be raised by a classroom to win a party is \$200.) Our Sun Day-Fun Day online kit offers suggestions for fundraising and incentives for your students. We encourage you to be creative and have fun!
